## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES & RESPONSIBILITIES



### SHOW USHER

Ushers serve as the primary "face" of the Emma Kelly Theater, responsible for providing high quality customer service and ensuring a safe, organized environment for patrons before, during, and after performances.

#### Responsibilities

- Greeting & Ticket Scanning
- Seating Assistance
- Patron Information - Distributing playbills, flyers, and answering questions about the building or show.
- Rule Enforcement - monitoring audience for any issues non compliant with venue policy.
- Guest Safety - Monitoring aisles & exits, assisting disabled guests, and leading orderly evacuations if needed.
- Theater Upkeep/ Clean Up

#### Essential Skills

- Interpersonal Skills
- Physical Stamina - able to stand for long periods of time and navigate stairs frequently.
- Attention to Detail
- Strong Communication Skills

### CONCESSIONS VOLUNTEER

A Concessions Volunteer at a live theater venue manages the food and beverage station in the lobby, acting as a hospitality host to ensure patrons have a high-quality experience during their visit.

#### Responsibilities

- Set - Up & Prep
- Transactions & Sales Totals- Greet guests, take orders, accurately process payments via cash or P.O.S system, and count sales numbers and report to House Manager.
- Food & Drink Distribution
- Inventory & Restocking
- Theater Upkeep/ Clean Up

#### Essential Skills

- Good Attitude/ Customer Service
- Physical Stamina - able to stand for long periods of time and lift small crates/boxes
- Basic Math Proficiency-able to handle cash and accurately calculate change.
- Reliability

### TYPICAL SCHEDULE & PERKS

Schedules can be made via email or phone with the volunteer coordinator and house Manager Pam Bolden. Requests & assignments will be given out at least 24 hours in advance. Shifts depend on performance assignments. Shifts typically last 2-4 hours and volunteers will need to arrive at least 60 minutes before show time.
